To the United Daughters of the Confederacy:

The undersigned, residing at Pickens who is an Ex-Confederate Soldier and a member of Camp No. 200 U. C. Vs., hereby, at your request, presents this Certificate of Eligibility for a Confederate Cross of Honor. He entered the service of the Confederate States on the 1st day of July 1863, as a Lieutenant in Company F of the 1st South Carolina Regiment of Volunteers, C. S. A. and was at that time a resident of Pickens

He was honorably discharged from said service by Maj Martin on the 13 day of April 1865, at which time he held the rank of Lieutenant J. H. Adams
