 who is an Ex-Confederate Soldier and a member of Camp No. \_\_\_\_\_ U. C. Vs., hereby at your request  
 presents this Certificate of Eligibility for a Confederate Cross of Honor. He entered the service of the  
 Confederate States on the 1st day of April 1864 as a Private  
 in Company A of the 2nd S. C. Inf. Regiment of  
South Carolina Volunteers  
 C. S. A., and was at that time a resident of Durham, N. C.  
 He was honorably discharged from service by General Sherman  
March 25, 1865 on the 25th day of  
March 1865 at [which time he held the rank of  
Private]
