MARCH PROGRAM

Our speaker for the program on March 18 will be Dr. Don McKale, Professor of History at Clemson University. His subject will be German Migration to America.

Dr. McKale was born in Kansas and grew up in Iowa. He was granted degrees from Iowa State, University of Missouri, and the Ph.D. from Kent State in 1970. He has taught at the University of Nebraska and Georgia College at Milledgeville, and came to Clemson in 1979.

Among his publications are a number of scholarly articles and three books on Nazi Germany, i.e., The Nazi Courts, 1974; The Swastika Outside Germany, 1977; Hitler-The Survival Myth. Dr. McKale is now working on two books dealing with the German Foreign Ministry and is engaged in a project for the Clemson Centennial Celebration. Guests would be welcome to enjoy this outstanding program.

GARNER-BOGGS AND RELATED FAMILIES by Stanley A. McGaha, 103 S. 4th Street, Easley, SC 29640. 142 pages indexed.

Mr. McGaha writes, "This book is an extension of *Garner-Keene Families of Northern Neck, Virginia* by Ruth Ritchie and Sudie Rucker Wood. *Garner-Keene* deals mostly with Virginia records while *Garner-Boggs* deals mostly with North and South Carolina records. *Garner-Boggs* overlaps the work of Ritchie and Wood with its Virginia records in order to achieve continuity. *Garner-Boggs* delves further in its English Ancestry than *Garner-Keene* but *Garner-Boggs* does not pursue the collateral Garner lines that Miss Ritchie's book contained."

The descendants of the two oldest children of Henry Garner, Jr. and Nancy Pool, Mary "Polly" Garner who married Henry Thomas Boggs, and Sylvania Garner who married Aaron Boggs, are listed to the fourth generation. Much credit is due Mr. McGaha for unravelling and keeping in order the children of the multiple marriages. Information on the first two daughters, Polly and Sylvania, and their descendants is fairly full, as is true for the other two girls, but information on the son and youngest daughter is not carried past the 1850 census.

Reading and understanding the descendants of Henry Garner, Jr. would have been easier had Mr. McGaha separated the Roman numerals from the Arabic numerals by periods and separated the generations by periods. Descendants of Henry Garner, Jr. and Nancy Pool will be glad to have such an extensive piece of research under one cover.
