BATTLEFIELDS' FAMILY FEATURE:

The National Park Service is making it a lot easier to research your family's Civil War record. Visitors to two battlefields - Antitam in Maryland, Shiloh in Tennessee - can type an ancestor's name into a computer to find out whether he was a Union or Confederate soldier, what regiment he was in and where that regiment fought. The information is limited now, but by 1995 the complete database will be accessible at all 28 major Civil War battlefields.
