Old Ninety Six District Chapter SCGS, PO Box 3468, Greenwood, SC 29648 **Family Bible Records** is off the press and ready for shipment. The records deal with families who resided in or migrated from SC in the late 1700's through the early 1900's. Many are from what is now Abbeville, Edgefield and Greenwood Counties. The book is 202 pages, full name indexed, printed on long-life paper and bound in a durable soft cover. The price is \$20 plus \$2 S&H for the first book and 50 cents additional books.

Isaqueena Falls and Creek are in Oconee, the northwestern most county of the state, a few miles northwest of the town of Walhalla (SC 28 and SC 107). Isaqueena was the fictional Choctaw name for the fictional Cherokee Indian maiden Catechee. The lengthy poem *Catechee of Keowee* (1898) by Dr. James Walter Daniel, is documented "proof" of her existence still accepted by many. (See Catechee.) It was at Isaqueena Falls, according to the legend, that the Indian maiden and her white lover, clasped in each other's arms, leapt to their deaths to escape the wrath of the Cherokee she had betrayed. 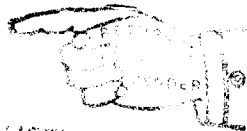
