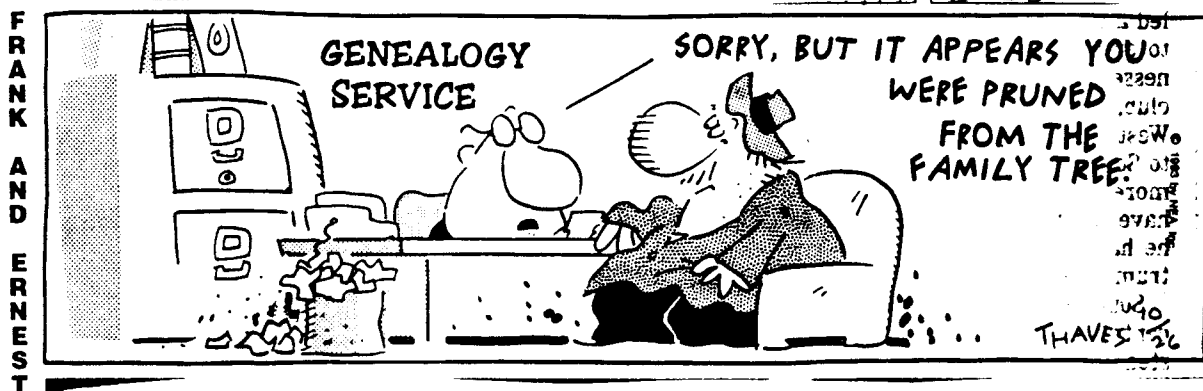
COST INCREASE:
