

CHAPTER CHARTER

WHEREAS a genealogy group from Anderson, Oconee and Pickens Counties, meeting in Clemson, South Carolina, has petioned the SOUTH CAROLINA GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY for membership as a constituent chapter and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the By-Laws of the SOUTH CAROLINA GENEA-LOGICAL SOCIETY, a chapter charter may be granted by unanimous vote of the Board of Directors, and

WHEREAS the Board of Directors of the SOUTH CAROLINA GENEA-LOGICAL SOCIETY did vote unanimously on 19 June 1976 to admit to its membership the genealogy group named above as a constituent chapter,

NOW, THEREFORE, effective this nineteenth day of June of the Year 1976, said group is now a member in good standing with said Society and is, therefore, vested with all rights, duties and obligations accorded a constituent chapter pursuant to the By-Laws of the SOUTH CAROLINA GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY and henceforth shall be known as

PENDLETON DISTRICT CHAPTER of THE SOUTH CAROLINA GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY

BY-LAWS

BY-LAW I NAME

The name of this Chapter shall be "The Pendleton District Chapter of the South Carolina Genealogical Society."

BY-LAW II CONSTITUTION

The basic governing statute of this Chapter shall be the current Constitution of the South Carolina Genealogical Society.

BY-LAW III CHAPTER BY-LAWS

Sec. 1. <u>MEMBERSHIP</u> - Membership in the Pendleton District Chapter shall be by application. The application shall be submitted to the Chapter, which, after investigation and approval by a two-thirds vote, shall forward the name of the member to the South Carolina Society.

Institutions, Societies and Individuals within and outside the State of South Carolina shall be eligible to nonvoting membership in the Chapter on payment of annual dues.

Sec. 2. OFFICERS - The Officers of the Chapter shall be:

President
Vice-President
Secretary
Treasurer
State Board Member

- Sec. 3. <u>ELECTIONS</u> All Officers shall be elected annually by the membership. Said election shall be held on the day of the annual meeting. The term of office for elected officers shall be one (1) year commencing January 1.
- Sec. 4. <u>Board of Directors</u> The Board of Directors shall consist of the Officers of the Chapter. The retiring President of the Chapter shall be an exofficio member of the Board. The Board of Directors shall have authority to transact the affairs of the Chapter during the interim between meetings. The current President and Secretary of the Chapter shall serve as Chairman and Secretary of the Board of Directors.
- Sec. 5. MEETINGS Monthly meetings will be held at 7:30PM on the third Tuesday Night of each month at a place designated by the Chapter. Meetings will be held Monthly, September thru June, with no meetings in July and August, unless desired by the membership.

The annual meeting will be held in November. At the annual meeting, the following shall be the order of business:

- A. Report of the Officers
- B. Report of Special Committees
- C. Unfinished Business
- D. New Business
- E. Election of New Officers

Sec. 5. Quorum - A quorum shall consist of Twenty-five Percent (25%) of the members in good standing at all meetings of the Chapter.

Three members of the Board of Directors shall constitute a quorum to transact the business of the Board meeting.

Voting on all questions coming before the Chapter shall be "Ayes and Nays" and shallbe entered upon the minutes of such meetings, and a decision shall be determined by the mayority of the votes of those present and in good standing.

- Sec. 6. $\underline{\text{DUES}}$ The annual Dues for membership in the Chapter shall be the annual dues for the South Carolina Genealogical Society. Additional Dues for Chapter operation shall be voted on by the membership.
- Sec. 7 <u>Committees</u> Committees shall be appointed by the President or Board of Directors as required for special prjects.

A Nominating Committee consisting of three (3) members of the Chapter shall be appointed by the President to serve for one (1) year. The nominating committee shall report to the membership their proposed slate of officers at the October meeting prior to the election to be held in November. Members of the Chapter in good standing shall have the privilege of submitting additional nominees to be considered, at the October meeting.
