The Pendleton Historical Commission now has renewed its stock of the 1897 map (by Mr. J. H. Von Hasseln) of Anderson County. This map has the name of the "head of household" on the map beside the residence even for people who rented instead of owned a house. This map is three feet square and costs \$3.12 tax included.

Mr. Richard N. Cote of the Charleston Chapter has written a book The Genealogist's Guide to Charleston Co., SC. This is the first of several proposed guides to SC counties.
