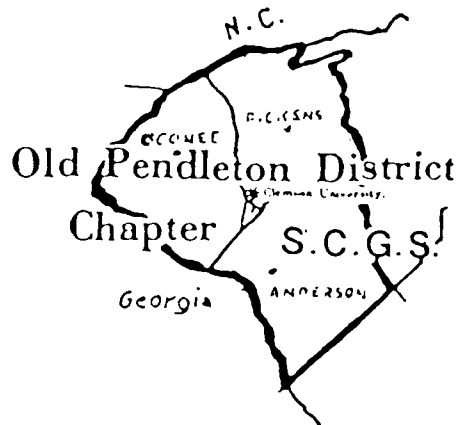
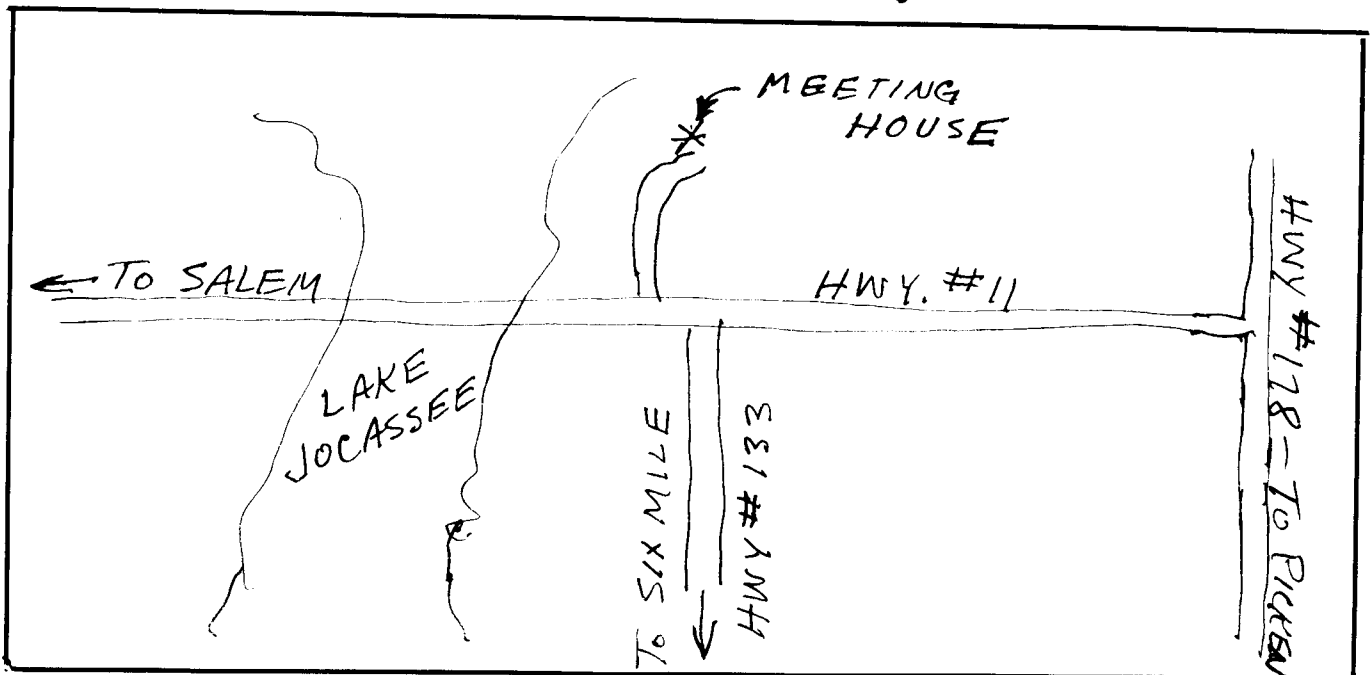


# SEPTEMBER MEETING

**PAPER FOUND IN THE PICKENS COUNTY  
COURTHOUSE BASEMENT FILES.**

SOUTH CAROLINA. Pickens District. October 17, 1863. The commissioners of the 5th Regiment, SCM submit the Following Report.

The Duties imposed on the commisioners by having to attend to the sending the Negroes to work on the Coast, and collecting the money for refusing to do so with the other duties incumbent upon them have been attended to as follows.

The Roads have been repaired to some extent, and if not as well done as might be expected by some; may be the want of hands to do the work.

The Bridges across the streams have been kept up so far as we know with but little expense to the District as the Report from the Treasurer will shew.

The collection of money by our Board from slave owners for refusing to send their Negroes to work on the Coast amounted to Twenty one Hundred and ten Dollars (\$2110.00) and placed in the hands of the secretary of our Board and has by him been paid over to Hamlin Beattie Greenville for check and sent to Wm. M. Shannon according to directions; said money being collected from the following persons as follows:
