

RECENTLY PUBLISHED:—by the Pendleton Chapter of the South Carolina Genealogical Society, <u>The Nicholson and Related Families</u>, by William C. Whitten Jr. and Mrs. Curron (Era) Davis. We had 50 copies prepared and they are selling well; 50% of them are already gone.


The book talks about the origin of the name and some prominent members of that name. Some early census records are given showing the extent of Nicholsons in early America. Two men to the Nicholson name seem to have been the progenitors of all later descendants in the Old Pendleton District. They were Benjamin and William Nicholson. The great majority are descendants of the latter and make up the major part of the book. It is 156 pages plus a thorough index and in soft cover. The cost is \$13 plus \$2 for postage.

Surely there must be other members of the Chapter who have large amounts of data on other families who would like to see that material put into a book. Why don't you get started on it? This applies to those members of the chapter who are remote as well as those who are able to meet regularly with us. If you feel that it is too much of a job, maybe another member of the chapter could work with you. That is what happened on the book above. 

Book Review

The Ancestry of Gene Ross including the Ross line and the associated lines of Bennett, Grimes, Llewelyn, Knighton, Turnbull and Kyle, by Gene Ross Kellough, privately printed Seneca, SC 1986. Soft cover, 8 1/2 x 11 pp. photocopied. Bibliography. Price is \$14 postage included. Order from Mrs. Gene Ross Kellough, 600 Old Salem Rd., Seneca, SC 29678.

The first 55 pages (indexed) trace her direct ancestry and descendants beginning with William Ross whom she believes was born in Virginia and moved to Tyrrell Co., NC and, seemingly, later to Martin Co., NC. Succeeding Ross families moved to Georgia and thence to Texas where Gene was born and spent much of her life. The text is interlaced with detailed records of source material, the most important being the Ross family Bible data. Some of these records did not photocopy too well but are a delightful inclusion.

A very interesting portion (151pp. not indexed) of the book, especially for family members, is the section titled "Samplings". It is a rapid review of her life and events while growing up in Texas 1909-1937 including a host of stories about people and life styles.

Gene and her husband John Stevens Kellough lived in 20 cities in 11 states before moving to Seneca for retirement. Her daughter and family had moved to Clemson.


Gene published the genealogy of her husband in 1981.




Mr. McGaha writes, "This book is an extension of Garner-Keene Families of Northern Neck, Virginia by Ruth Ritchie and Sudie Rucker Wood. Garner-Keene deals mostly with Virginia records while Garner-Boggs deals mostly with North and South Carolina records. Garner-Boggs overlaps the work of Ritchie and Wood with its Virginia records in order to achieve continuity. Garner-Boggs delves further in its English Ancestry than Garner-Keene but Garner-Boggs does not pursue the collateral Garner lines that Miss Ritchie's book contained."

The descendants of the two oldest children of Henry Garner, Jr. and Nancy Pool, Mary "Polly" Garner who married Henry Thomas Boggs, and Sylvania Garner who married Aaron Boggs, are listed to the fourth generation. Much credit is due Mr. McGaha for unravelling and keeping in order the children of the multiple marriages. Information on the first two daughters, Polly and Sylvania, and their descendants is fairly full, as is true for the other two girls, but information on the son and youngest daughter is not carried past the 1850 census.

Reading and understanding the descendants of Henry Garner, Jr. would have been easier had Mr. McGaha separated the Roman numerals from the Arabic numerals by periods and separated the generations by periods. Descendants of Henry Garner, Jr. and Nancy Pool will be glad to have such an extensive piece of research under one cover.

Bolding Family, Jonathan Lee Bolding, 1806-1879, a pioneer citizen of the Pea Ridge Section of Pickens County, South Carolina. A history of his life and times and a listing of his many descendants, is concerned with the Boldings who settled and built up the section in the northeastern part of Pendleton District called Pea Ridge.

The first 55 pages contain a history of the early settlers of the area. Many anecdotes continued before and after the War, the sicknesses that could not be cured, the continued production of babies despite the loss of many in infancy give the reader of a feeling of existence during great hardships.

Of the 12 children of Jonathan Lee Bolding and Rebecca Powell Bolding, eight are listed in detail often to the sixth generation but no where is noted a geographic location other than Post Ridge. Family Tree Name listing contains 8480 names. First married name listing has 260 names. Current married names list 100.

- 3. Any book submitted becomes the property of the Old Pendleton Chapters of the South Carolina Genealogical Society.
 - 4. The book must be accompanied by price and where it can be obtained.

Bible Records

Please help the Chapter increase its collection of Bible Records by sending yours to the Bible Records Chairman.

Original records, machine copied duplicates and transcriptions (typed copies) are acceptable. Non-members are also invited to submit South Carolina Bible Records in order to preserve them for future generations. Please write to the Bible Records Chairman Mr. W. E. Woodson Jr., 326 W. Main Street, Liberty, SC 29657 for details.

We still must devise a method of informing our members of our Bible Record holdings and a way to make them available to all members even though not locally located. You will be informed about this when worked out.

Surname List

Our surname list is badly out-of-date. We would like to start over and create a new up-dated list. We will try to up-date periodically and mail to you.

- 1) Submit SURNAMES only. Keep a record of surnames previously submitted.
- 2) Submit each SURNAME ONLY ONCE NO MATTER HOW LONG YOU REMAIN A MEMBER.
- 3) Surnames submitted must have a South Carolina connection.
- 4) Surnames must be typed or printed. Names in script are not accepted.
- 5) Only 25 surnames may be submitted in any one six-month period.
- 6) Include your name, address and Society membership number.
- 7) Send SURNAMES directly to the Surname List Chairman: Mrs. Margaret Goodman,
- 109 Allee Street, Clemson, SC 29631.

Queries

A <u>MEMBER</u> is allowed two Queries each quarter - EIGHT free queries per membership year. The two queries may include up to a total of fifty (50) free words. Name, membership number and address are printed free, and are not included in the word count. Additional words cost five cents (5) EACH. MEMBERS may also submit additional queries at the cost of five cents (5) for EACH word. Payment for extra words must be sent when the query is submitted. The same query may be submitted only once each year. Queries will not be accepted from non-members.

Queries may relate to any family, any time and any place. For maximum effectiveness, all queries should include a place and a date or time span even if only approximate.

Each queries, to be accepted, must be on a 3 x 5 card. TYPE or PRINT clearly with no abbreviations. Capitalize all surnames within the query; do not Capitalize any other words. Include your name, membership number and address with each query. Proofread your query carefully. Include payment for any additional words (see above). Any query not meeting these requirements will not be published.

The following example is provided to assist you in determining the word count. It is based on 2 free queries containing 25 words each.

EXAMPLE: Desire parents of Robert A. Hardy born 4 June 1800 any town, any county, any state. Married Gertrude SMITH about 1820-22 NY. Children; John Henry; James D., Mary A. Moved to Iowa 1840. Died 1850.

Total word count - 36. Figuring 11 additional words at 5 cents per word, the additional cost would be 55 cents. Please note each initial counts as one word and each part of a date is a word.







SOUTH CAROLINA. Pickens District. October 17, 1863. The commissioners of the 5th Regiment, SCM submit the Following Report.

The Duties imposed on the commisioners by having to attend to the sending the Negroes to work on the Coast, and collecting the money for refusing to do so with the other duties incumbent upon them have been attended to as follows.

The Roads have been repaired to some extent, and if not as well done as might be expected by some; may be the want of hands to do the work.

The Bridges across the streams have been kept up so far as we know with but little expense to the District as the Report from the Treasurer will shew.

The collection of money by our Board from slave owners for refusing to send their Negroes to work on the Coast amounted to Twenty one Hundred and ten Dollars (\$2110.00) and placed in the hands of the secretary of our Board and has by him been paid over to Hamlin Beattie Greenville for check and sent to Wm. M. Shannon according to directions; said money being collected from the following persons as follows:
