- 1922. J. B. Gravely died on January 25. He was a Confederate Soldier. He joined the Methodist Church at the age of 16 and lived 77 years a Christian for 77 years. Age 94 years.
- 1922. L. B. Gravely Daughter Died Same year.
- 1922. On March 5 James Washington Lawrence Passed away at the age of 89 years 6 months.
- 1922. William Chapman father of Mansell Chapman Dyed March 19. Age about 75 years.
- 1922. Wm. Thomas Bowen Passed away at his son on March 20 at the age of near 79 yrs. He served Pickens County in the house of Representatives and State Senate and was a good man Generally.
- 1922. Rev. Clarence L. Craig was Killed by Lightning on Keowee River was Burried The following day at the Old Craig Burrieng ground on Keowee. July 18 at 5 o'clock P.M.
- 1922. William L. Morgan Died Augt 7 1922. An Old Confederate Veteran of the Civil War. Aged 78 years.
- 1922. Capt. W. B. Allgood Dead. he was a Confederate Soldier went through all the civil war. he was a Mason belonged to Secona Baptist Church and died and was Burried on December Age about 86 years.
- 1923. Robert L. Gillstrap Died on May the 18, 1923. aged about or near 67 years in August next. Died near Seneca SC in Oconee Co. was Burried Next day near Westminister, the 19 at Tabor church in Oconee.
