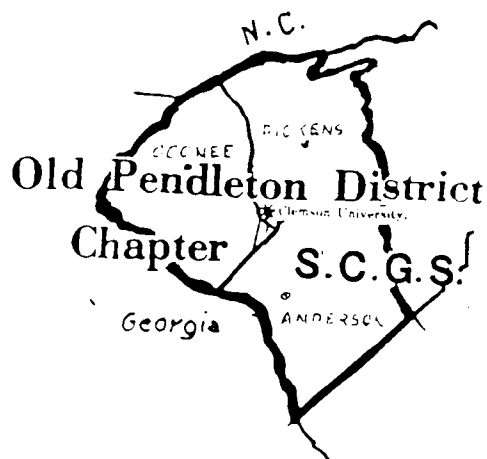


MARCH MEETING

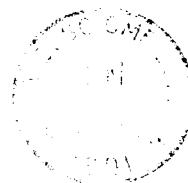
