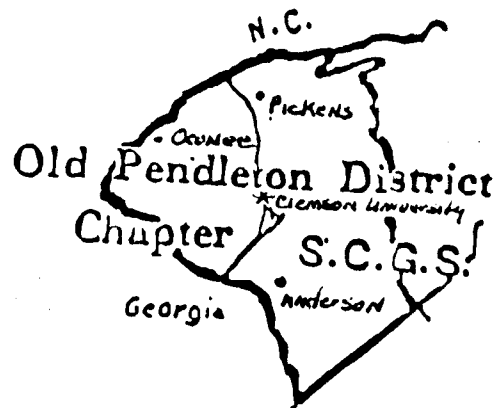

## FAITH CLAYTON

We were saddened by the death of Miss Faith Clayton, Dec. 17, 1993. She was a Charter Member of the Pendleton Chapter of SCGS, as well as a member of many other local state and national organizations. We will always be indebted to her for guidance, leadership and generosity in helping develop and preserve our cherished family histories. The following was printed in The Greenville News, Dec. 19, 1993:

Faith Clayton, formerly of Central, a former member of the state Industrial Commission, died Dec. 17, 1993, at Laurel Hill Nursing Center in Pickens. She was 86.

She was formerly associated with the South Carolina Employment Security Commission as a manager of the Liberty Office. She also served an eight-year term as commissioner with the South Carolina Industrial Commission. She was a graduate of Central Wesleyan College and was a former public school teacher in Mississippi and in Pickens County.

After her retirement, she took up the study of genealogy, and in 1984, she donated her extensive collection to Central Wesleyan College where it is now housed in the Faith Clayton Family Research Center. She was the oldest alumna of Central Wesleyan College.

Surviving is a sister, Mrs. Fred (Angie) Parham of Latta.

Graveside services: 3 p.m. Sunday in Sharon United Methodist Church Cemetery.

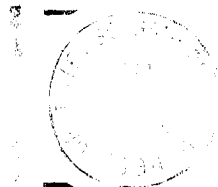
