WHERE TO FIND FAMILY NAMES

SOME BASIC INFORMATION

PICKENS COUNTY became a separate county in 1868. To research family names prior to 1868, check the Pendleton District records/histories such as History of Old Pendleton District (975.725 Simpson).

Unfortunately, there is very little available in printed records since Pickens County became a county in 1868.

Birth and Death Records were not required by the State of South Carolina until 1915.

Marriage Records from July 11, 1911, are located in the Pickens County Administration Building, Pickens, South Carolina.

(The only earlier birth, death, and marriage records are from newspaper and church notices, Classification number 929.3)

Wills from 1828 are located in the Pickens County Administration Building, Pickens, S. C.
