### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

- I, like a majority of our members, reside outside of the State of South Carolina. It didn't take long to realize that Pendleton District genealogical research has its pitfalls.
- 1. There are no birth, death or marriage records for South Carolina prior to 1915.
- 2. The church records of the predominantly Baptist and Methodist Churches are not the greatest as far as birth, death, or marriage dates go. However, they are great if you want to find out who got kicked out of church for swearing, drinking, cursing, dancing or "frolicking" (Seems like the "National Enquirer" was alive and well in early South Carolina.)
- 3. Most of the early obituaries were written by ministers and went something like this: "Sam Jones died last Wednesday and leaves five grieving children and a sorrowing widow. He was buried in the Jones Family Cemetery." No mention of his father and mother, no mention of his wife's name or her maiden name no mention of his children names or ages.
- 4. Upper Pendleton District was not free of Indians and open for settlement until after the Hopewell Treaty of 1784, even though some claim to have settled prior to this time.
- 5. Land records prior to 1828 are not found in the courthouses.

These are just some of the obstacles to research in this area. In the coming months, I and others in the chapter will try to suggest ways to overcome these problems. There are solutions! Have fun and keep on digging..... Joe

So far as getting whiskey by express is concerned Pickens is now dry, and has been for about two weeks. The Southern Express Co. has no office in Pickens and it refuses' to turn over whiskey to the Pickens Railroad Co. Up until about two weeks ago a fellow could order his gallon shipped to Pickens and it came all right, but now he has to have it shipped to some point where there is a Southern Express office and go and sign in person for it. After April 25, when the new quart-a-month law goes into effect, there will probably be no "ordered Likker" in Pickens, as no person would hardly go to the trouble necessary to get a quart and then go eighteen miles to Easley after it. That is, it is nine miles to Easley. If one opened his package as soon as he got it we don't know how far it would be coming back.

### CRAIG AND ALEXANDER BURYING GROUND

Five miles north of where old Pickens court house stood and one mile south of the site of old Fort Prince George on the eastern banks of the Keowee River, is one of the oldest cemeteries in Pickens County, which is known as the Craig and Alexander grave yard.

Many members of these two old prominent Pickens county families are here buried as is witnessed by the fact that more than a hundred graves are visible. A large number of these graves are unmarked. Probably the first marked grave is that of Johnnie Craig who was a Revolutionary Soldier and was buried one hundred and ten years ago. According to his request the following epitaph was inscribed on his tombstone: "Free Trade, State Rights, Liberty or Death."

There is another grave near by with a soapstone head rock marked J.G. died Jan. 22 1835. This is said to be the grave of John Gresham who once lived in Pickens District and owned a considerable amount of land. It is thought he was a relative of Col. Joseph Gresham who lived a long while at Old Pickens. (Note: John was father of Joseph Gresham) Several Confederate soldiers are buried here among then are W.M.S. Craig, John Craig, A.R. Craig, L.C. Craig and E.B. Alexander.

It will be remembered that L.C. Craig was elected sheriff of Pickens District while serving in the Confederate army in Virginia, and a few days after his election, was wounded in battle and died a few days after reaching home. He was never sworn into office as sheriff.

This old historic graveyard has in the past been sadly neglected, but recently the Craigs and Alexander's as well as others who have relatives buried there, have done a great deal of improvement and their purpose is to beautify it still more. Sg: T.A. Pickens Sentinel Issue: 30 Nov 1922

My name is Milley M. Crow. I live at Daholoega, GA Rt #3. I was born in Pickens Co., SC. I claim Indian blood. I don't know what tribe my grandmother belonged to. If I ever heard I forgot it.

I claim through my father. My father died in 1880. He was about 70 years old when he died. He was born in SC too, in Pickens Co. I claim through my father's mother. I don't know where she was raised, but she lived in SC. I came to GA in 1847. My father, my grandmother and I have never gotten any money or land from the Govt. on account of our Indian Blood.

In 1882 I was living in Lumpkin Co., GA. I did not know anything about an enrollment at that time. My father and I lived with white people, but the Indians were there. I never heard of my father living with the Indian tribe.

When the Indians were carried off, I was living in Pickens Co., SC. There were not Indians living there at that time. They had all come to GA. My father did not go off with the Indians. I don't know why he did not go with the Indians. They did not drive him away. I have been taught all my life by my mother and uncles and aunts that I was part Indian. I claim through my great grandmother. Her name was Eaton. That was her name after she was married. I don't know her given name. Signed: Milley M. Crow, Dohlonega, GA 13 July 1908.
