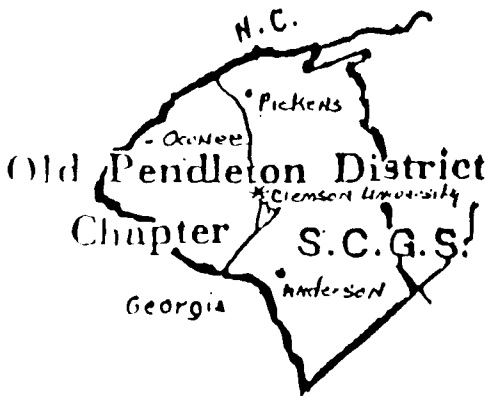


MAY 1996 MEETING

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Please allow me to make a few comments. It won't be long as I don't want to take up space in the Newsletter that might be used for more important bits of genealogy.

This message is really directed mostly at the members of our chapter who don't attend our meetings. For most of you that is because you are a long way off, and you make the judgement that it is too costly in time and money to make the trip. Nevertheless, it is not the least bit unusual for there to be one or two out-of-staters attending each of our meetings.

I want all of you to know that the Chapter is thriving as never before. A large degree of credit for this has to go to the 1995 President, Joe Looper. He gave us great leadership in 1995. Our membership has grown to over 240 members--the majority of whom live out-of-state. We are having 40 to 45 at each meeting.

Our Newsletter Editor, Linda Cheek, has contributed to the good health of the Chapter with her energetic publishing of the Newsletter. Many of you have helped her by submitting queries, family group records, pedigree charts, bible records and other assorted forms of genealogical records. I'm sure she appreciates this material. Keep it coming.

The SC Society has two meetings annually. These will be announced in the Carolina Herald. If they haven't already. One is held in July, usually in Columbia, at which speakers try to impart some wisdom on genealogical matters to attendees. The other is the annual business meeting of the Society, held by one of the Chapters, this is held in November. The host Chapter will have a banquet, visits to local historical sites will be scheduled, a speaker will talk about some subject of genealogical interest, etc. When the Carolina Herald announces these things you might give some consideration to attending. There is always a chance that you will pick up some "gem" of family knowledge from associating with other genealogists.

You have seen in our Newsletter, of course, that one of our activities is publishing books of family histories and of other forms of genealogical data. These are usually the result of one, or a few individuals. One book was written, and then another, and then others. Our inventory of books got rather low in 1995 and we spent a good deal financing reprints of books. Now our inventory is largely replenished and our Treasury is being replenished by the book sales.

Blue Ridge View Baptist Church was organized in 1916 and met in the old Blue Ridge school which was located on the present day cemetery site. In 1938 a church was built across the road and was used until 1977 when a new building was constructed with "free labor" by its members approximately 1/8th mile from the cemetery.

Location: From Easley, HWY 135 north to left on Jamison Road, right on Wolf Creek Road. Cemetery is on the hill at the intersection of Boundary Lane and Wolf Creek Road.

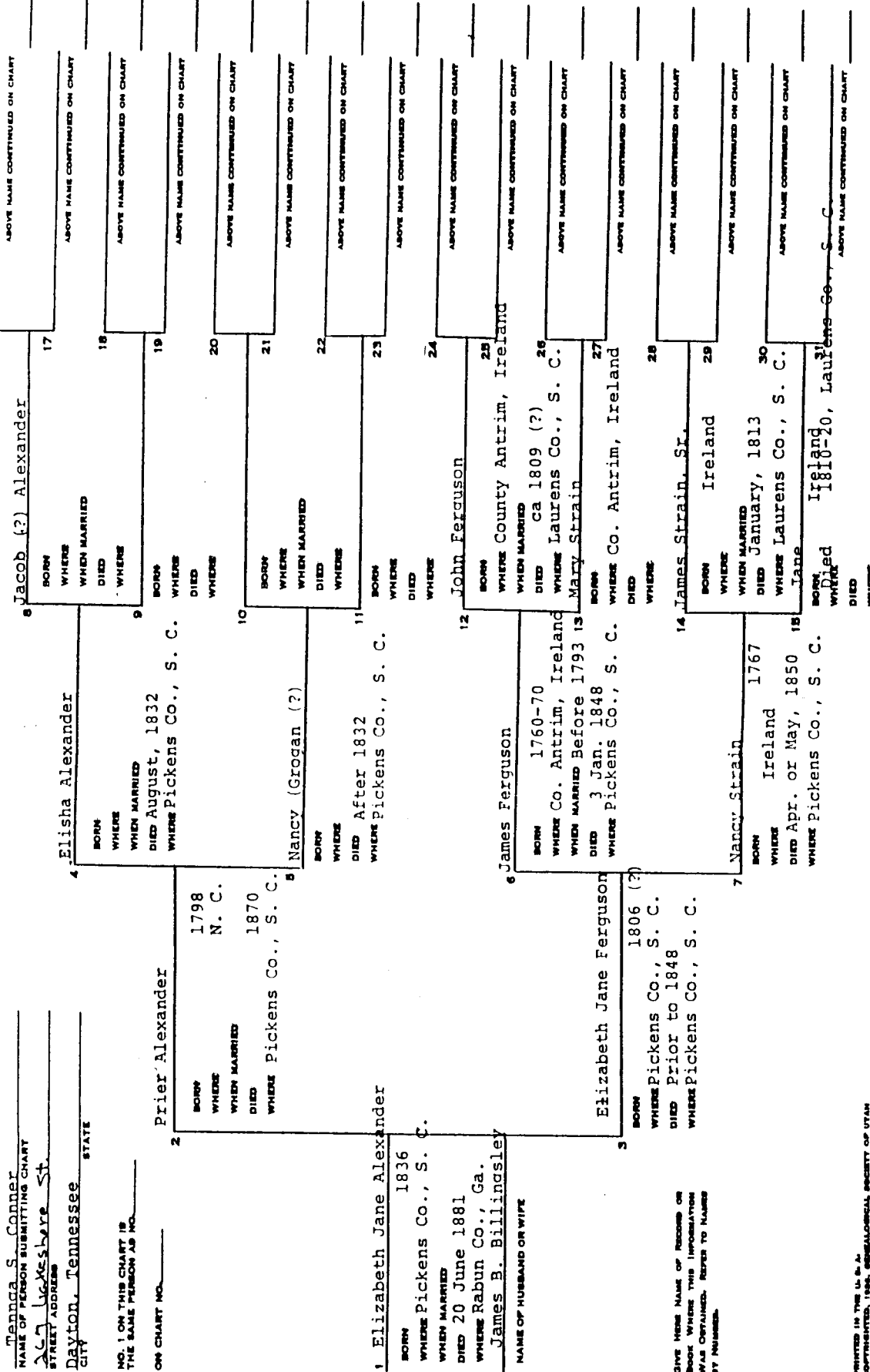

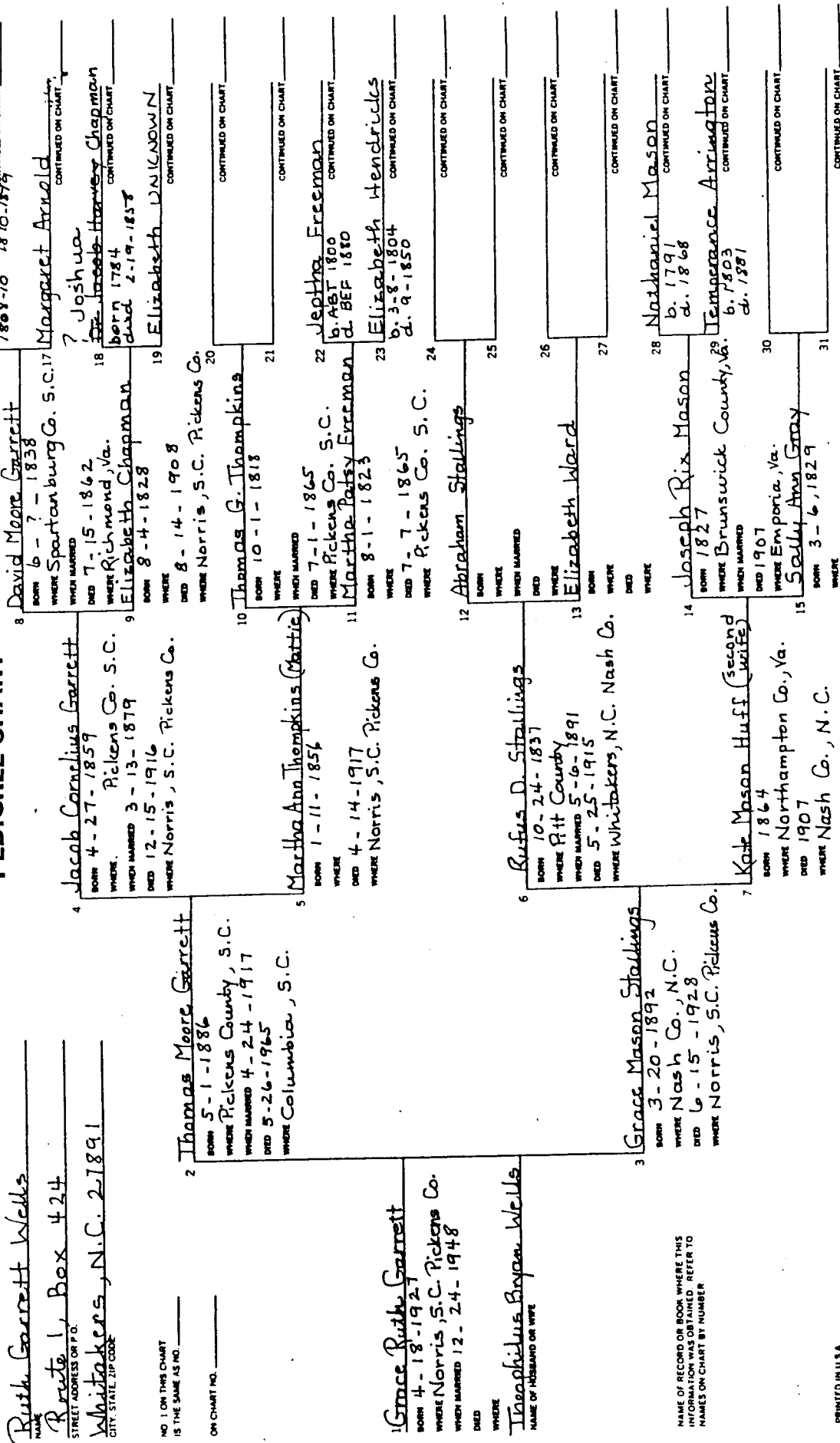
