In the name of God Amen I Moses Holland of the State and County afore written being weak of body but of sound memory and perfect understanding knowing that it is appointed for men to die and after death to come to judgement I do hereby constitute this to be my last will and testament and what ever wordly goods it has been pleased God to bless me with I do give and bequeath in the form and manner following viz: First I bequeath my soul to God who gave it and my body to be buried in a decent manner at the will of my Executors hereafter named. I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Gracey all my personal and real Estate and goods and chattels whatsoever during her natural life or widow-hood after that time to be Equal Divided between the lawful heirs of her body namely Moses, Aaron, Caleb, Joshua, Tabitha and Elib--I also give and bequeath to my daughter Ellender one dollar also to James one dollar to heirs of Chesley one dollar to John one dollar to Fanny one dollar and to Thomas one dollar. I hereby nominate and appoint William Acker Esq my lawful executor of this my last will and Testament and lastly that he disposes of such of my property as he thinks proper to discharge my lawful debts. Revoking and setting aside all other will or wills heretofore made by me. Dated 3 Sept 1829 Sg: Moses X Holland Wit: Henry Cobb, William Magee, H. Rice. Rec. on 9 Nov 1829



Columbia Chapter, SCGS announces publication of Founding Families of the State of South Carolina.

In 1997, the Columbia Chapter of the South Carolina Genealogical Society sponsored a new heritage program titled *Founding Families of the State of South Carolina* in celebration of South Carolina's two hundred and tenth birthday. Membership in *Founding Families* was open to all persons who could prove direct descent from an ancestor who settled in South Carolina prior to May 23, 1788, the date South Carolina became a state. To qualify for membership, each applicant proved descent from the ancestor (male or female) by an acceptable record or records for each generation, including proof for the applicant. Acceptable proofs for this project included birth, death, marriage, bible, church and census records. Also, cemetery, probate, military records, and information from published family histories were accepted as proof documentation. Copies of these records are on file in the Columbia Chapter Archives. The information provided by applicants serves as a valuable resource for other researchers and genealogists and is a valuable addition to the history of South Carolina.

This book is in two sections. Section I contains the listing of ancestors, connecting family surnames and *Founding Families* member(s) who descend from that ancestor. An every surname index is included for this section. Section II contains a copy of the original descent charts submitted for membership in *Founding Families*. Each descent chart contains the names of the ancestor, *Founding Families* applicant and connecting families. Listed on the bottom portion of the chart are the documents used to prove each generation of descent. Not all descent charts are included. In the case of more than one application submitted for an ancestor, the descent charts are printed for the initial applicant and any other applicant whose line of descent changed by more than two generations.

This 400 page, softbound volume is being offered as a pre-publication special. There are no plans for printing after this offering. The pre-publication price is \$45.00 postpaid and must be received by November 1, 2000. All orders will be mailed by December 15, 2000.


TINKLING SPRING CHURCH



The Rev. Basil Smith

The Rev. Basil Smith was born 1 May 1772 in Georgia, and his wife, Amelia (Milly) was born 12 June 1773 in Virginia. Their dates of birth were recorded in a bible that was originally owned by Basil and passed to his son Joseph. Several people copied the data from this bible, which included a listing of Basil's children along with their dates of birth. Also copied from this bible were the names of others, who are suspected to be the brothers and sisters of Basil. However, different individuals came up with different names from the bible for Basil's brothers and sisters. This could be the result of poor handwriting used in recording the data, the age and condition of the bible when the data was copied, errors on the part of those who copied the data, or a combbination of the above. It is speculated that Basil and Milly were married in 1794 since their first child, Mary, was born 22 Feb. 1795.

In a book written by Grace Smith Pettijohn in 1912, entitled "Smith-Pickens," it is stated that Basil's parents were Job Smith and Susannah Clayton. According to the noted genealogist, Leonardo Andrea, this book which primarily covers the Pickens family, has some information about Basil's brothers and sisters. The book states that Job Smith was of Scottish descent and that he came to the 3&20Creek area in Pendleton S. C. from Virginia. The Smith line is carried forward only through John, a son of Job. She list children of Job that she got from one of the eldest members of the family:

In a letter dated Feb. 24,1962 from David Smith of Spartanburg, S. C. to Patrick C. Smith, David reflects on an earlier visit and

conversation. He lists the following as th data from the bible:

Later in the letter he says he thinks there was one more entry after Thomas Smith that wasn't legible.

It is hard to know for sure exactly what names were recorded in the bible. If there were two Dorcas Smiths listed, one could have died young and a later daughter given the same name or the second entry could be a correction of the earlier entry. Also one of Basil's brothers could have married a Dorcas. The listing for Thomas Hallum could be Thomas Hallum Smith or one of Basil's sisters could have married a Thomas Hallum. There seemed to have been some Smith-Hallum marriages in the late 1700's. In fact a Joseph Smith, who was enumerated next to Basil in the 1800 census was reputed to have married Elizabeth Hallum. This same Joseph, who died around 1814, had a son Job, who was executator of his estate, and some believe Joseph was Basil's father.

Based on a careful review of all of the above, it is my belief that the following were Basil's children:

As stated earlier, Basil and Milly were enumerated 717 in the 1800 census next to Joseph Smith (over 45 and with one slave) 716. George Mc Gee was 718. Others close by were Matthew Mullinax 712, Moses Cannimore 714, Christopher Kirksey 723, Henry Garner 730, John Garner 729, John Mullinax 746, Enoc Smith 758, Job Smith 793, and William Hallum 803. Most of these individuals probably lived in the viginity of Golden Creek and 12 Mile Creek. An interesting side note is that a Phillip Porter was listed next to 2 Joseph Smith with one slave in the 1790 census. Phillip Porter is reputed to have married Mary (Mollie) Smith, a sister of Basil.

The f ϕ rst recorded purchase of land by Basil Smith was on Nov. 30, 1809, when he bought land (I believe to be 170 acres) from John Garner on Tarrancy Branch. The deed was witnessed by Hiram and Nancy Cochran. Basil and family must have lived in the vicinity of Golden

Creek and 12 Mile Creek, northeast of Liberty S. C. until sometime in 1831. Basil sold 170 acres for \$800, the same price he paid for it, to Nancy Pullum/Pullam on Tarranty Branch and James Borings Branch. Milly, wife of Basil signed her release with John Garner and Darcey Barton being witnesses. The deed was dated 9 March 1831. An interesting note is that on December 5, 1831, a Job Smith of Fayat Georgia, sold 100 acres on a branch below the old meeting house to Nancy Pullam. The deed was witnessed by Basil Smith and Jacob Guston. I speculate that this Job Smith was Basil's brother. Also it is probably just a coincidence that there were Nancy's involved when Basil bought his land and when Job sold his. It could have been a relative who remarried.

On Dec.15, 1831 Basil bought 282 acres on the Saluda River from William Slaton for \$1000. The deed was witnessed by Caleb Cartee and Aaron Welborn and released by Sary Slaton. Of interest is that Basil's son Phillip married a daughter of William Slaton. I never found where Basil sold this tract of land. It may have been given to some of his children. The location of this land isn't clear, but probably was in the Brushy Creek area or near Honea Path.

Basil purchased 480 acres for \$400 from Younger Wilburn on Oct. 20, 1832. This land was part of a 1000 acre grant to Micajah Clark in 1792 on the Pickensville Rd. on a branch of Hurricane Creek and another branch of Hurricane Creek and Big Creek. This deed was witnessed by Micijah B. Williams and John Harper. This parcel of land or a part of it (no acrage specified) was sold to William Harper on Sept. 2, 1837 for \$350 by Basil with a release by Amelia, wife of Basil. Witnesses were Spencer Cartee and William Elliott.

Then on Jan. 9, 1852 Basil bought 151 acres on 18 Mile Creek for \$1200 from Abner Odell and wife Mary S. Odell, with Robert C. Scott and A. M. Hamilton as witnesses. It is worth noting that Abner Odell and wife Mary were involved in the settlement of the estate of a Susannah Smith around 1855. Basil sold this parcel with the same witnesses to his son Joseph on March 18, 1852 for \$1200, paid or secured. There was no dower release, which probably means that Milly had already died. This deal was probably for Joseph and Anney to look after Basil in his last few years and not actually pay for the land. Joseph later sold this same tract to his son W. E. Smith in the late 1800's with the provisions that W. E. care for Joseph and Anney.

No estate settlement has been found for Basil, which means he probably disposed of his assets prior to his death.

Basil was a local Methodist Minister as indicated in the Smith-Pickens book. There are also a number of marriage extracts found in the Greenville Monitor and the Pendleton Messenger that lists Basil as the minister. The following was copied from the book "Early Methodism in the Carolinas" by Rev. A. M. Chreitzberg in 1897:

But to take up the old Keowee records. The Quarterly Conference for 1833, sixty-three years ago, had Malcolm McPherson for presiding elder, and John W. Mc Call as preacher in charge. Local preachers: Levi Garrison, Robert Gaines, R. Shockley, William G. Mullinax, Phillip Elrod, Willis Dickerson. Exhorters: William Rhodes, Samuel Hamby, James Shockley, Basil Smith. Class Leaders: Lawsom Mullinax, John Golden, Thomas Gassaway, Anderson Smith, Thomas Evitt, William Fleming, Robert Pickens, Joel Ledbetter, John Ledbetter, Wesley Earp, John Morris, Hugh H. Whittecur, Sidney Smith, Allen Harbin, John Adams,

James Holland, Thomas Carpenter, Dugal Me Kellar, James B. Clark, Washington Clark: and Garrison Linn, steward.

Of interest is that Phillip Elrod was a neighbor of Basil in both the 1840 and 1850 censuses. Of personal interest to me is the William G. Mullinax, who was my g-g-g-grandfather on my mother's side.

GEORG According to the 1850 census, Basil was 78 years old, born in , and owned \$1300 worth of personal property and real estate, of which part of this was four slaves. He was enumerated as head of household 634 in the Eastern Division of Anderson County, S. C. The following census data with ages was taken from the 1850 census and represents people who lived close to Basil: Phillip Elrod, age 63 and born in N. C. was #631. Other than him being a Methodis Minister with Basil, the only other reason to mention him is that a number of Elrods lived near this set of Smiths, and Milly may have # ## Elrod (no real reason to assume this.) Next to Basil, at #635 was Richard Fleming, 38 and Nancy, 40 , was 636. The reason for listing the Flemings as neighbors is that a James Fleming, 78, was in the home of William F. Cartee, 31, enumerated 979, and Fleming was William F. Cartee's father-in-law. Basil's daughter, Milly, married Spencer Cartee, whom I sure was a brother to William F. Cartee, and both sons of Reubin Cartee, 59, #741, born in Virginia. After Nancy Flemming was William Hallum, 62, NC, #637; Then #638 was William Wilborn, 53, SC (note land transactions.) George Elrod,58 NC, was #640 and Strother Kay, 49 was 644. Strother Kay lived near Neals Creek Church. I will list some other heads of households, that I found interesting in the general area. Some may be connected with Basil and others probably aren't.
