**Well the New Year has started with the US Postal Service raising the price of postage. The Newsletter was costing us .55 cents per newsletter to mail and beginning the 7th January 2001, it will go up .22 cents each making the cost .77 cents per newsletter. This would cost Old Pendleton about \$100.00 more a month to mail. So..... some changes are going to have to take place because Old Pendleton cannot afford to pay more for the Newsletters. We are only breaking even now with the dues, and the profits we make are from book sales and needed to re-print books etc.**

**Beginning with this February Newsletter I am going to reduce the amount of pages to 24 (the printer requires sets of eights) in each Newsletter, rather than raise the cost of dues. ## **WILL OF JOSEPH WOOD:** State of South Carolina, Pickens County Box 1 No. 8

I Joseph Wood being in my sound reasons as common yet having a view of death before me, I make  
and own this as my last will and testament after my death I desire that the Lord Jesus will take my soul  
to himself in glory and as to my affairs I want as much of my property sold as will pay my just debts  
then I allow all the children that I had by my first wife Lavisa to have one dollar a piece that is to say  
one dollar for Nancy and one dollar for Charity and one dollar for William and one dollar for Easter  
and one dollar for Solomon and one dollar for Winny and one dollar for Isaiah and one dollar for  
Catherine and one dollar for Lavisa and what is left I want my present wife Mary to have to raise her  
children on. I want my wife to have the property or possession that I have till her death unless she  
should marry again and if she should marry after my death I desire whatsoever remains of my property  
to be sold and divided as the law directs with the children that Mary my wife has bore to me. If my  
wife should remain unmarried till her death if there be any property yet remain let her children divide  
it equal among them this being my last will and testament. Signed 6 Jan 1829. My wife Mary is to be  
my executer to have the whole power in her hand. Joseph Wood X. Wit: Philip Snead, Jacob Lewis  
and Daniel G. Nix. Proved 2 Feb 1829 Rec. 2 Feb 1829.

Estate appraised 2 March 1829 by: Jacob Lewis, Thomas Alexander, Jacob Guyton, William House,  
Alfred Roper.

**DIED:** Mrs Susan Kennemore died at the residence of her son-in-law, Mr Abraham Roe in this  
County on Friday the 19th inst, aged 94 years. She retained her mental faculties remarkably well in  
her old age and furnished the late Col. Goodlett many interesting facts in writing his reminiscence of  
this County which was published in the Sentinel a few years ago. Pickens Sentinel Issue 25 May 1876.

in the bottom of Mr R.E. Steele's of Keowee River in this County. The place is near old Fort George  
and the probability is that the bones are those of an Indian or a Revolutionary War Soldier. Pickens

**MARRIED:** By the Rev. Richard Phillips on the 10<sup>th</sup> inst, Dr Major J. Lewis of Cumming, Forsyth County, Georgia, formerly of Rock Mills, Anderson District, SC to Miss Evelina Jane, daughter of Thomas Leneir, Esq. Of Gwinnette County, GA. Highland Sentinel Anderson Co SC 27 May 1842.

**DIED:** One of the old land marks of this County is no more, Mr Joel Jones aged 86 years died at his residence in this County on Friday the 13th instant. His remains were buried in the family burying ground on the old homestead on Sunday after his death. Mr Jone was, we believe, a soldier in the War of 1812 and when the late war between the North and the South broke out although old was one of the first men in the County to volunteer, and offer his services to this native state. **"SOME" CONFEDERATE WIDOW PENSION APPLICATIONS IN PICKENS  
COUNTY SOUTH CAROLINA PROBATE COURT-ANNEX. BY THE ACT OF 1919.**

---

**M.T. HOGAN--MALINDA HOGAN:** I am the widow of M.T. Hogan of Orrs Rifles under Capt B.F. Martin who enlisted in May 1861 and served in that command until discharged at Greensboro NC on the 26 April 1865. I was married to him 4 Sept 1892. My husband died 4 May 1902. I am 80 years of age and reside at Easley in Pickens Co SC and have lived there since 22 March 1907. Signed Malinda Hogan x. Dated 9 Jan 1930.

---

**MARTIN HOLDER:** I enlisted in Co Hamptons Batt, Reg of Cavalry under Capt Hart on the 10 July 1861 and served in that command until the 20 April 1875 when discharged at Greensboro NC. I was born on the 15 March 1839 and reside at Easley, Pickens Co SC. Sg: Martin Holder x. Dated 27 Oct 1919. Wit by S.M. Looper and Riley Simmons.

---

**R.G. HUNT:** I enlisted in Co F Reg of Cavalry 2nd Batt SSC under Capt John Westfield on 1 June 1861 and served in that command until the 18 May 1865 was discharged at Greensboro NC. I was born on the 17 Jan 1838 and reside at Dacusville, Pickens Co SC. My health is still feeble not able to do much work. Sg: R.G. Hunt dated 8 April 1919. Wit by: R.T. Prior of Co B Reg 2nd SCC and S.M. Looper of Co L 2nd SCC.

---

**MARTIN JOHNSON: CELIA M. JOHNSON:** I am the widow of Martin Johnson who enlisted in Cp A 29 Reg. Of NC Infy under Capt Anderson in April 1861 and served in that command until the 9 April 1865 was discharged at Appomattox. I was married to him 27 Dec 1865. My husband died 27 Aug 1875. I reside at Pickens Co SC. Wit by James A. Griffin of Co H 4th SCV and R.A. Bowen of Co E 2nd SC Rifles.

---

**O.T. JONES:** did service for the Confederate State in Co E under Capt Bowen 2nd SC Rifle Reg. Dated 19 June 1915. Pension missing.

---

**JOHN THOMAS KAY:** did service for the Confederate States in Co. C. Under Capt L.F. Anderson 4th Reg. Sg: John Thomas Kay. Dated 3 March 1917. G.W. Sullivan swore he John T. Kay was a bona fide Confederate Soldier.

---

**J.D.M. KEITH:** I enlisted in Co C of 4th SC Cavalry under Capt J.C. Calhan on 15 Nov 1862 and served in that command until 26 April 1865 when discharged at Greensboro NC. I was born on 18 Sept 1844 and reside at Marietta RR2 in Pickens Co SC. Sg: J.D.M. Keith. Dated 15 April 1919. Wit by: A.K. Edens of Co F 22nd and W.B. Jones of Co H 2nd SC Rifles.

---

**W.A. LARK:** I enlisted in Co G 16th SC Reg of Infantry under Capt J.W. Bolling in Oct 1861 and served in that command until 9 April 1865 when discharged at Appomattox VA. I was born on the 27 June 1845 and reside at Easley, Pickens Co SC. Sg: W.A. Lark dated 28 March 1919

---

**JAMES H. LAWRENCE: SARAH A. LAWRENCE:** I am the widow of James H. Lawrence who enlisted in Co B Reg of Palmetto SS under Capt Wallace on 9 April 1863 and served in that command until 9 April 1865 when discharged at Appomattox. I was born 16 June 1847. I was married to him on 8 Nov 1860. My husband died 2 June 1919. I am 72 years of age and reside at Calhoun in Pickens Co SC and have lived there since 1847. Sg: Sarah A. Lawrence dated 20 Sept 1919. Wit by: B.J. Johnston of Co I 62 Reg NCT and C.M. Martin of Co A Orrs Rifles. Another paper on J.H. Lawrence: Dated 23 June 1915 James H. Lawrence enlisted in Co E under Capt Littleton in 2nd Reg SC.

, And when he moved to his new home assisted in organizing the Three And Twenty Presbyterian Church , the name of which was early changed to Richmond , and afterwards to Carmel, and at first stood on the ground on which the Pickens Methodist Church now stands . in 1790 the congregation at Carmel consisted of about sixty families . In 1788 or 1790 , the Pickens families became Methodist and Carmel was removed to its present site on the Pickens side of the line .

After a long and useful life , Captain Robert Pickens , died July 19th , 1830 , and was buried in the family graveyard which had been located on his place .

There is an old Plantation on which one of the branch of this family settled on the waters of George's Creek , about two miles west of the Saluda River , half way between the city of Greenville and Easley , S.C. . A grist and flower mill were built on this place , and after a time a cotton gin and saw mill were added . This mill was known as Bowen's Mill , but it has since passed out of the family , and is now known as Kay's Mill . In the early days there was a blacksmith's shop located near the mill.

D Mary B. Pickens , daughter of John and Nancy Bowen Pickens , was born in the Northwestern part of South Carolina , on Three and Twenty Creek , October 27th , 1800 , and died near Athens , Tennessee in 1839 .

Before the Civil War he was Colonel of the Second Battalion State Troops ,and it was from this he earned the title of Colonel William Pickens . He was amumber of Mathodist Church ,and furnished a greater part of the means to build a new church near his plantation .

Colonel William Pickens ,was married three times . His first wife was Julia Welbron ,who was born October 29th ,1825. His second wife was Mrs. Emeline Smith (nee Oliver ) a daughter of Dr. Oliver . his third wife was the widow of Wigington Phillips .Her Naiden name was Martha Louisa Rush .
