

Mr. Marshal please don't think for a moment that it was carelessness or indifference that I did not write you by Thursday mail. I had not heard from you and did not know what to write. I will meet Pa at W. Wednesday, or at least I will go to meet him if he comes. Miss Jamie wants us to send for her soon. She is looking very thin says she hasn't strength to kick now. Do write at once. Please excuse paper. I am just out. Will have a new supply in a few days. As ever yours in sincerity. Helen.



"Some of our citizens—we beg pardon—some of the citizens of the US, residing in this province, were, not long since in serious fear of the insolvency of the SC Banks from the dread consequence of Nullification. We trust that all apprehensions on that score are removed, and that SC money has regained its credit. We cannot, at any rate, but express our entire willingness to receive it in payment of all debts due to ourselves without any discount whatever." "We regret to be compelled to allude to the question at all, but it is evident that there is a fixed design on the part of some of the fanatics of the North, to bring about, if possible, the interference of the government with the question of slavery." (Further information).

Departed this life on the 7th inst. (April 7), at his residence in this district, **Andrew Liddell**, **Sr.**, aged about 83 years . . . born in Newcastle Co., MD, where he resided until he was nearly grown. He settled in Abbeville District where he continued during the **Revolutionary War**. Two of his brothers were killed. In **1790**, he settled in **Pendleton District**, at the place on which he died . . . left 6 sons, 3 daughters, 72 grandchildren, and 35 greatgrandchildren . . . membership of the Presbyterian Church . . . hero of Revolutionary War . . . (eulogy).







Cherokee museum to be first in the state.

Luther Lyle introduced his current project, the Museum of the Cherokee in South Carolina, to the Old Pendleton District Genealogy Society during the February meeting. Lyle is a retired teacher from Walhalla and a member of the Cherokee Bear Clan of South Carolina. A local historian, he has been involved with placing Historical Markers in the Upstate area.

Lyle provided OPD members with brochures on the "History of Oconee County" and "Cherokee Indians in the Upstate." Lyle explained the different spellings of the word Oconee which means "land beside the water." As a member of the Oconee Arts and Historical C omission, he was part of a committee involved with creating a new seal and flag for Oconee County. The seal features a design composed of the Native American symbols for land and water.

In the early 1700's, Oconee was one of the Lower Towns of the Cherokee nation. It was located on the main trading path between Charleston and the Mississippi River. "The Cherokee trade path was in Charleston, long before the white people," said Lyle.

During his presentation, Lyle described the layout of a typical Cherokee village, each with its seven clans. He described long houses and roundhouses, and explained the meaning of the phrase "stomping ground."

He had many photographs of "trail trees" that were created by the Cherokee to mark known paths. He said the Cherokee bent young, white oak tree saplings to grow into trail trees that were generally about 50 feet apart along the trail. Lyle said several hundred of these trees have been identified including some in Oconee County.

Lyle told the group about plans for a Cherokee museum in Walhalla. The 1400-square foot building is located on Short Street across the street from the Oconee County Courthouse. It is currently in need of funds to purchase the approved doors and windows. Lyle hopes that with grant money and contributions the museum will be able to open later this year.

"People are already donating the artifacts for the museum," said Lyle. "When it opens, this museum will be the only one of its kind in the state of South Carolina."
