Save the Dates of April 24-26 for the 5th annual Upcountry Reunion

Plans are underway for the fifth annual Upcountry Reunion, set for April 24 through 26 in Pickens County. This three-day event includes speakers, classes, tours of local family history research centers as well as popular cemeteries, and concludes with an all-day genealogy swap-meet.

Activities begin on Thursday at the Hampton Memorial Library in Easley with a genealogy class to be held in the Computer Lab and an Open House in the Gregorie Historical Room in the afternoon.

That evening, Professor Tim Drake will discuss "Death, Burial and Mourning Customs in the 18th and 19th Century South." Drake is a noted historian and descendent of Revolutionary War General Andrew Pickens. He is a member of the Pendleton Historic Commission and the Old Pendleton District Genealogical Society.

On Friday, several cemetery tours are planned at different times. Also, visitors can tour the Pendleton District Commission Archives.

The main event is Saturday from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. in Founders Hall at Southern Wesleyan University in Central. Families will display genealogical research, pictures, Bibles, old documents, and other ancestral memorabilia. A copier and printer will be available to help share information, charts, pictures and other items.

During the day, guest speakers and special tours are scheduled. In addition, local historical and genealogical groups will also be available. Participants can enjoy lunch upstairs in the Dining Commons.

This unique Upcountry family history event continues to grow thanks to funding from the Pickens County Accommodation Tax, and is sponsored by the Birchwood Center for Arts and Folklife, Old Pendleton District Genealogical Society, Southern Wesleyan University, Central Heritage Society, Faith Clayton Family Research Center, Pickens County Historical Society, Pickens County Museum of Art and History, Pickens County Library and Pendleton District Commission.

BEN ROBERTSON OF PICKENS COUNTY

INTRODUCTION

This is the first part of a biographical sketch about Ben Robertson, who was an outstanding and nationally-known American journalist and foreign correspondent during World War II. A native of the Palmetto State, he was born June 22, 1903 at Calhoun (now Clemson) in Pickens County. In 1923 he was graduated from Clemson Agricultural College (now Clemson University) and in 1926 he also obtained a journalism degree from the University of Missouri. Then, Ben began his impressive career as a professional journalist -- a career that is briefly summarized in the following paragraph (and will be discussed more thoroughly in a forthcoming part of this article).

Ben Robertson first worked in Charleston, South Carolina as a reporter for the *News and Courier*, and about one year later he went to New York and served on the staff of the *New York Herald Tribune*. In 1934 he accepted a job with the Associated Press and was assigned to its bureaus in both New York and London. He also served as a correspondent for the newspaper *PM* in London. Ben loved to travel, and he went to Hawaii where he was a reporter for the *Honolulu Star-Bulletin*. After having ventured on to Australia, he became a reporter for the *Adelaide Star-Bulletin* and *The News*. When he returned to the United States, he penned articles for some South Carolina newspapers of the upcountry, including *The Greenville News*, *Anderson Independent*, and *Anderson Daily Mail*. Moreover, he wrote articles published in *The Saturday Evening Post*, *Travel*, *Asia*, among other popular magazines. In addition to his newspaper work, Ben authored three books, *Travelers' Rest* (1938), *I Saw England* (1941) and *Red Hills and Cotton: An Upcountry Memory* (1942).

The competent newshound, war correspondent and author of published books was killed on February 22, 1943, when a Pan Am airliner named the *Yankee Clipper* crashed during a storm into the Tagus River in Portugal while the pilot was attempting an emergency landing at Lisbon airport. After Ben's body was found, identified and returned to South Carolina, the journalist was buried in West View Cemetery at Liberty in Pickens County. Many close relatives of Ben Robertson are also buried in the same Liberty cemetery. Among them are his father, Benjamin Franklin Robertson, Sr. (1873-1943); his mother, Mary Iola (Bowen) Robertson (1877-1910); his stepmother, Hattie (Boggs) Robertson (1885-1918); his maternal grandparents, William Thomas Bowen (1843-1922) and Rebecca (Allgood) Bowen (1848-1925); his aunt, Elizabeth "Bettie" (Bowen) O'Dell (1875-1943); his uncle, Wade C. O'Dell (1873-1953); and some of his cousins, including Dr. Alfred Taylor O'Dell (1899-1948), who was a professor of English at Furman University.

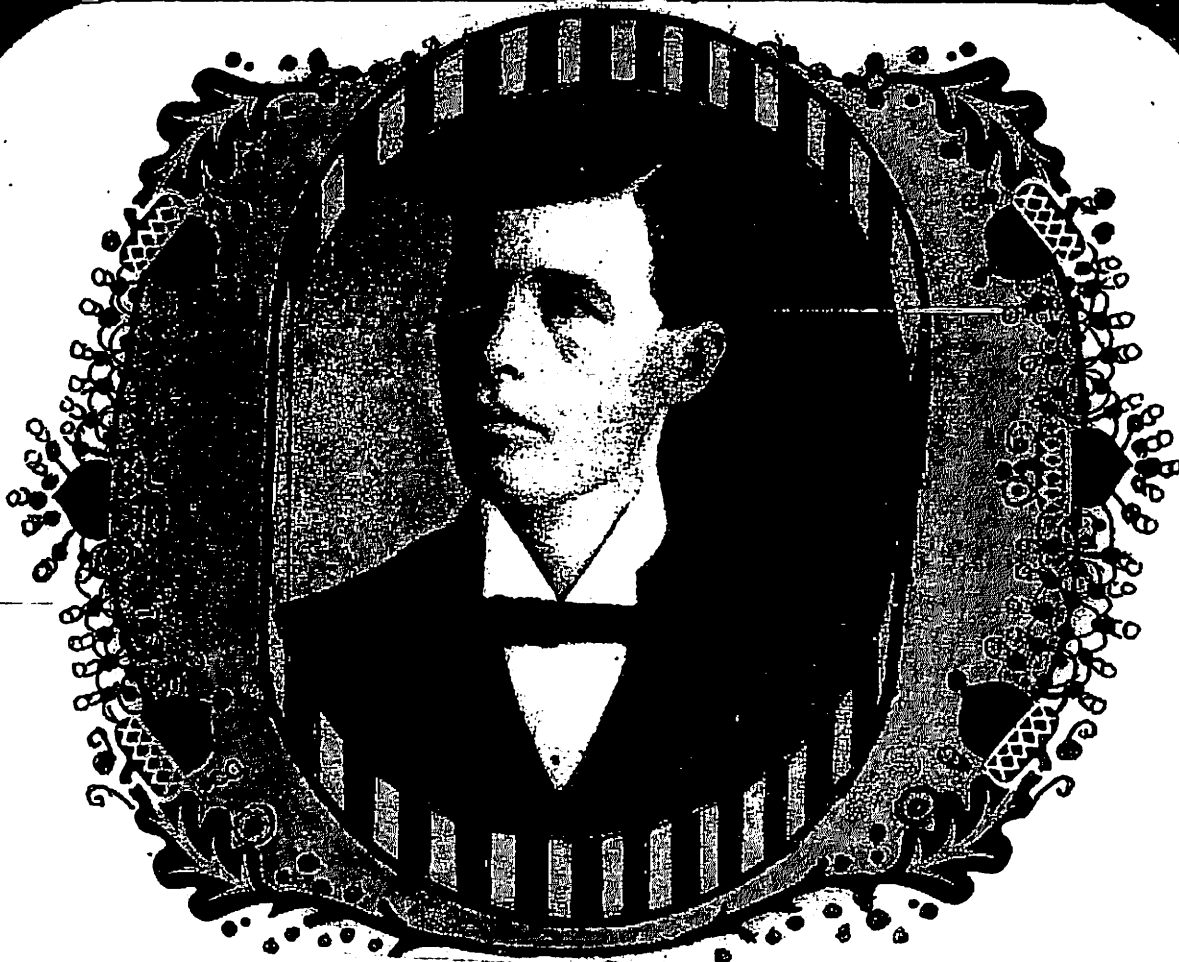
**BENJAMIN FRANKLIN ROBERTSON, Sr.
and

Benjamin Franklin Robertson, Sr. was born August 2, 1873 in Pickens District, South Carolina. He died July 2, 1943, only a few months after his son Ben Robertson was killed in the crash of the Pam Am airliner the Yankee Clipper on February 22, 1943 in Portugal. The senior Mr. Robertson was a son of Thomas Lafayette Robertson (1840-1902) and Artemissa (Clayton) Robertson (1837-1907).

Thomas Lafayette Robertson was a Confederate soldier during the U.S. Civil War. At the age of twenty-two, he enlisted as a private in the CSA army at Camp Pickens, situated in northern Anderson District's Sandy Springs community. Then, he served in Company E, 1st South Carolina Regiment (Orr's Rifles), commanded by Miles M. Norton of western Pickens District (now Oconee County). The regiment was soon sent to Virginia where Thomas Lafayette Robertson served throughout most of the Civil War and was wounded in action. During the war, the soldier advanced in rank from that of private to sergeant. On April 3, 1865, shortly before General Robert E. Lee surrendered the Army of Northern Virginia at Appomattox, sergeant Robertson was captured by Union troops at Petersburg, Virginia and sent, as a prisoner of war, to Hart Island in New York Harbor. Shortly after the Civil War ended, he was paroled and then walked from New York to his home in Pickens District, South Carolina.

The Confederate veteran and his wife, Artemissa (Clayton) Robertson, had the following children: Phillip Clayton Robertson (26 Jul 1868 – 4 Apr 1936), who on February 16, 1905 married Anna Lenora Seaborn (14 Jul 1878 – 27 Mar 1957); Frances Amelia "Frankie" Robertson (25 May 1871 – 3 Jun 1912), who married Stephen Wight O'Dell; and Benjamin Franklin Robertson, Sr. (2 Aug 1873 – 2 Jul 1943), who married Mary Iola Bowen (6 Oct 1877 – 24 Dec 1910); and Samuel McGowan Robertson. Confederate veteran Thomas Lafayette Robertson died near Cateechee in Pickens County on February 2, 1902 and was buried in the Phillip Clayton Family Cemetery near the intersection of the Stewart Gin Road and Belle Shoals Road in Pickens County.

Ben Robertson's father, Benjamin Franklin Robertson, Sr., grew up on his father's farm near the Twelve Mile River in Pickens County. The farm was situated on land obtained by an ancestor as a bounty for his military service during the Revolutionary War. The family's farmhouse was the birthplace of Benjamin Franklin Robertson, Sr. and his siblings. After Clemson Agricultural College was established in 1889 about twelve miles south of the Robertson's farm, Thomas Lafayette Robertson told his son Ben that he was willing to either send Ben to the new college or to give him land on which he could establish his own farm. The choice was left up to the son, who quickly decided to continue his formal education. Then, he was matriculated into the institutions very first class in 1896. In 1899 Benjamin Franklin Robertson, Sr. received a

B.S. degree from Clemson College and then joined the staff and faculty of his alma mater at Calhoun. While serving in Clemson's chemistry department, Mr. Robertson was appointed state chemist. Moreover, he became a very capable toxicologist who was often called on for his expert advice concerning poisons, particularly in legal matters concerning persons or animals whose deaths could have been caused by exposure to toxic substances, including insecticides and poisons used to kill rats.

In 1901 Benjamin Franklin Robertson, Sr. married Mary Iola Bowen (1877-1910), an early graduate of Winthrop College at Rock Hill, South Carolina. She was a daughter of Confederate veteran William Thomas Bowen (1843-1922) and Rebecca Amelia (Allgood) Bown (1848-1925). The Couple's wedding was held on August 16, 1901 at the home of the bride's parents in Pickens County. Later, the couple had two offspring, Benjamin Franklin Robertson, Jr. (1903-1943), who became widely known simply as Ben Robertson, and Mary B. Robertson, who married Julian M. Longley, and then lived in Dalton, Georgia for many years. In 1892 Mrs.

Longley donated Ben Robertson's papers to the Pickens County Historical Society, and they were deposited in the Pickens County Museum at Pickens, South Carolina.

When Ben Robertson and his sister Mary B. were very young children, their mother, Mary Iola (Bowen) Robertson, passed away at the age of only thirty-three years. Two years prior to her untimely death, she suffered from a bout of typhoid fever which badly weakened her body. But her death two years later was apparently caused by diabetes, but she was not aware that she was a diabetic. According to Robertson family oral tradition, in December 1910 Mrs. Robertson was cooking cakes, cookies, and candy at her home in Calhoun. The sweet treats were to be used during the Christmas holidays. While cooking the sweets, Mrs. Robertson also tasted and ate some of them, and later she became very ill because of the large sugar intake. She then died on Christmas Eve of 1910. She was buried in the Robertson family's plot at West View Cemetery in Liberty, South Carolina. Her two young children were then left without their loving and caring mother.

After their mother's death, Ben, age seven, and Mary B., age five, were placed in the Liberty home of an uncle and aunt, Wade C. O'Dell (1873-1963) and Elizabeth Mahala "Bettie" O'Dell (1875-1943). Mrs. O'Dell was a sister of the mother of Ben and Mary B. Robertson. The O'Dell's resided on Commerce Street in Liberty, where Mr. O'Dell was a successful farmer and a rural mail carrier and the owner of much land. The O'Dell's son Alfred Taylor O'Dell (1899-1948), who was a cousin of Ben and Mary B., and also lived in the household where the Robertson children had been placed. Mr. O'Dell was a son of William Taylor O'Dell (1847-1933), a Confederate veteran, and Ary (Parsons) O'Dell (1849-1938). The young Alfred Taylor O'Dell, who was a first cousin of the Robertson children, became their playmate in Liberty. Later, he taught English at Furman University and married Catherin McGlothlin, a daughter of the president of Furman University.

After Ben and Mary B. had resided for two-and-a-half years with the O'Dell family in Liberty, their father, Benjamin Franklin Robertson Sr., married his second wife, Hattie Boggs (1885-1918), daughter of Marcus Arthur Boggs (21 Nov 1849 - 16 Oct 1927) and Rebecca S. Boggs (5 Jul 1842 - 18 Apr 1889) of Liberty. Mr. Robertson, the father of Ben and Mary B., then returned the children to their former home in Calhoun. Then, their stepmother "Momma Hattie", helped to care for them until her death from influenza during the 1918 influenza epidemic that killed an estimated 548,000 people.

Hattie Boggs Robertson died three days after she had helped to care for many sick Clemson cadets who had influenza and were placed on cots in the textile building on the Clemson College campus. She was buried in West View Cemetery at Liberty and was survived by her stepchildren and by Hattie Boone Robertson, the only child born to her and Benjamin Franklin Robertson Sr.

Hattie Boone Robertson later married Fredrick Wohlke Wagener (5 Feb 1914 - 4 Nov 1949) of Brooklyn, New York. Mr. Wagener was a son of Henry L. Wagener (d. 1958) and Henrietta Ellen Catherine Wohlke Wagener (1886-1934). Mr. and Mrs. Frederic Wohlke Wagener had the following three sons: Dr. Earle Henry Wagener (b. 6 Feb 1941), who graduated from Clemson University in 1962 and married Susan Parker; Dr. Ben Robertson Wagener (b. 29 Mar 1943), who graduated from Furman University in 1965 and later from Princeton Theological Seminary in New Jersey and who married Dorothy Ann Spencer; daughter of Dr. Lewis and Elizabeth Spencer; and Dr. Ken B. Wagener, who graduated from Clemson University in 1968 and married Margaret E. Monroe.

Benjamin Franklin Robertson, Sr. died July 2, 1943 and was buried in West View Cemetery at Liberty. His tombstone contains the following inscription: THE SALT OF THE SOUTHERN EARTH.

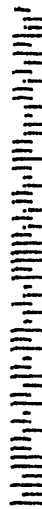
