## South Carolina Genealogical Society to host 43rd annual Summer Workshop July 10 & 11

The 43rd Annual South Carolina Genealogical Society Summer Workshop will be held July 10 and 11 at the S. C. Archives and History Center in Columbia.

Registration begins at 8:45 on Friday, July 10. A "Hands-On" Tour of the Archives begins at 10 a.m.. That afternoon there will be a variety of speakers, including OPD Archivist & State Representative Anne Sheriff, who will speak about the Pickens County Confederate Project. Other topics that afternoon include Genealogy and Historic Preservation, Finding Your Scalawag An-

cestors, Reconstruction in South Carolina, African-American Research in South Carolina and more. A speaker's reception, with light refreshments will be held at the Marriott Courtyard that evening.

Saturday's events include more speakers on a wide range of topics including DNA for Genealogists, SC Proprietary Research, Sherman's Flame and Blame Campaign, What's New on FamilySearch, Roberson County, NC; Lessons from the Records of Slaves and Free Persons of Color, Roots and Recall.com, Case Study of Hark West, Sr., A Famous Enslaved Horse Trainer, Understanding the Online Index at SC Archives, Early Migration Trails and Routes from Virginia and Early Trails and Routes in South Carolina.

Coffee and doughnuts will be served during registration and a catered lunch is planned. Displays will be open beginning at 8:30 a.m. and the SCGS Board will meet during lunch.

Webmaster, Paul Kankula shared with us the story of his trip to the Abbeville Court House. Entering the courthouse he found to his surprise that there were ledgers stacked to the ceiling that had not been digitized.

He and a friend have scanned or photographed 34 ledgers beginning in the late 1700's that contain over 10,000 names alphabetized and are now on the Abbeville Genealogical Society Website.

Paul is now working with Greenwood County.

Brenda Meyer shared information about her trip to Salt Lake City, Utah for the Federation of Genealogical Societies and OOTSTEC Annual Conferences Feb. 10-14. She told us about researching at the LDS Family History Library.
