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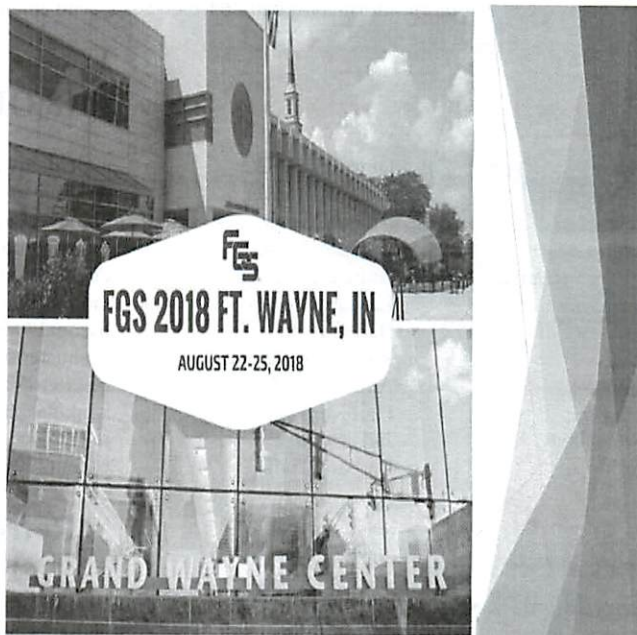

19 Jun 1868, page 3, col. 4. **Pickens Equity Court. Thos. J. Pickens vs. F.W. Pickens and others. Andrew C. Pickens, Mary B. Anderson and Robert Anderson** reside out-of-state. On motion of **Mr. Noble**, complainant's solicitor, absent defendants appears with 40 days. **Robert A. Thompson**.

19 Jun 1868, p. 3, col. 6. **B.W. Bell**, Walhalla, SC. Advertisement for store.

26 Jun 1868, p. 2, p. 5, Col. 5. Oakway, SC, 30 May 1868. The Center Union Democratic Club met. Motion of **J.B. Sanders** inviting all "colored persons to join in with us by giving their names and attending our meetings as spectators and will give them instruction and encouragement to get them to set for the good of themselves and their country." Gentlemen elected as delegates to the Central Association to be held at Walhalla on 6<sup>th</sup> June: **T.H. Simmons, F.C. Brown, L.C. Brown, W.T. Simmons and J.A. Simmons. C. Maret**, President, **J.B. Sanders**, Secretary.

26 Jun 1868, p. 5, col. 5. Advertisement. Meeting of Farmers and Mechanics Cooperation Association to be held at Farmers' Hall, Pendleton Village on Saturday the 4<sup>th</sup> of July next at 12 o'clock. **R.J. Pearce**, Agent.

26 Jun 1868, p. 3, col. 2. Advertisement. Walhalla Female Seminary will begin First Monday in July and end last Friday in November. **Miss C. Morgan**, Walhalla, SC. Inserted in nsp. 15 Jun 1868.

26 Jun 1868, p. 3, col. 2. Advertisement. Secretaries of clubs auxiliary to the Central Democratic Club of Pickens County, are requested to be present at its next meeting at the new Court House on 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday in July at 10 o'clock. Also, a meeting at Salubriety on 4<sup>th</sup> of July. **Wm. L. Rogers**, President. Inserted in nsp. 16 Jun 1868.

26 Jun 1868, p. 3, col. 2. Heirs and Representatives of **Richard H. Mansell**, deceased, be present on 5<sup>th</sup> of Aug at Estate of **Richard H. Mansell** where administrators, **Mathew Mansell and J.G. Ferguson**, will pay off heirs. Inserted in nsp. 9 Jun 1868.

26 Jun 1868, p. 3, col. 2. **James M. Sloan** will practice medicine at Pickens Court House. Inserted in nsp., 28 Nov 1866.

3 Jul 1868, p. 1, col. 3. Report of Immigration, Charleston, 18 May 1868 to Governor James L. Orr. "Since my last report to your Excellency, thirty-one persons have been registered in this office, and have found employment in this State. There are now twenty persons on the way from Germany and Scandinavia, via Baltimore, and may arrive in a few days. The registries of lands now embrace 332,660 acres, in almost every district of the State, for sale at reasonable rates and on favorable conditions; and nearly 6000 acres of good lands in salubrious section of the State have been registered to be given as a free donation to actual settlers, upon reasonable conditions of improvement. " etc. May 18, 1868. From **John A. Wagener**, Commissioner of Immigration.

3 Jul 1868, p. 3, col. 1. "We are informed that at the sale of Town Lots at the location for the new Court House for Pickens County, on Thursday last, some seventy-five lots were sold at an average of \$90 per lot. These lots, we believe, contain from one-half to two acres. A number of \_\_ yet remain unsold; so those who may want to buy, will yet have a chance.

**3 Jul 1868, p. 3, col. 3.** Mr. Morris Miller, of this District, informs us that, one day last week, during a thunder storm, he had five head of cattle killed by lightning. In the lot were four mile milch cows.

**24 Jul 1868, p. 2, col. 2.** U.S. Marshall selling whiskey, mules, wagon and etc. belonging to Sam'l A. Dike was sold by Deputy Brown. Violation of Internal Revenue Laws. The whiskey sold for \$2.00 per gallons. The mules, wagon, & etc. brought \$5.00.
