

Lula Bess Keese Bowen April 16, 1917 - September 5, 2018



Westminster – Lula Bess Keese Bowen, 101, widow of the late Dewey Ryal Bowen, 5857 West Oak Hwy, passed away Wednesday, September 5, 2018 at her residence.

A native of Oconee County, she was the daughter of the late Elijah Bibb and Bessie Mahala Crawford Keese. Mrs. Bowen's (fondly called Mama B) great family work was centered on the genealogy of her family. She spent many, many hours doing research in libraries, archives, books, and classes tracing the origins of her ancestors. She was so delighted with this work and shared it with all of her family as well as distant relatives. Her labor of many years researching upstate families will be donated to the Faith Clayton Genealogy Room at Southern Wesleyan University in Central, SC.

Another great love for her was the Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) organization. She became the

Regent of the Walhalla Chapter NSDAR in 1984 and delighted in the meetings, both at home and in other areas/states. She felt that the importance of family history was paramount in her family culture, along with the stories of survival and hard work during the Depression. She and her relatives were hard-working people who lived off the land and worked hard to make their way. She leaves behind a keen interest in family history in many of her children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren. She also was a proud member of Bethel Baptist Church.

Survivors include her sons, Dewey Keese Bowen of Walhalla, John Ryal Bowen of Oakway, and Edward Eubanks (Tara) of Oakway; daughters, Mahala Bowen Moore (Dennis) of Colbert, GA, and Peggy Bowen Moore (Don) of Westminster; eleven grandchildren; and twenty-four greatgrandchildren.

In addition to her husband and parents, she is preceded in death by brothers, Bill, Samuel, and Martin Keese; and sister, Marguerite Keese.

A funeral service will be held 2 pm, Sunday, September 9, 2018 at Bethel Baptist Church. A private family burial will follow. The family will receive friends from 6-8 pm, Saturday, September 8, 2018 at Sandifer Funeral Home.

Jerry Lamar Alexander September 3, 1937 - November 6, 2018

Longtime local newspaperman Jerry Alexander will be remembered for his hard work, warm smile and love of history,

Jerry Alexander will be remembered for his hard work and relentless energy that led to a long career in the newspaper industry, as well as his smile and engaging personality that left a lasting memory on those he met.

Alexander, who owned the *Pickens Sentinel* for nearly 25 years until its sale in 2001 and stayed active writing books and newspaper articles in recent years, died last week, at age 81.

While spending almost a quarter of his life at the local Pickens paper, his career in journalism dated back to at least the late 1960s. He also formed a magazine publishing firm and authored a number of books on local history.

"Jerry was a great publisher and writer that truly cared about his community and worked tirelessly to better it," said Jerry Edwards, owner of *The Journal* in Seneca. "He had a smile and a kind word for everyone he met."

Rocky Nimmons, a publisher of the *Pickens County Courier*, said Alexander hired him right out of college despite a lack of journalism experience. But Nimmons said Alexander was more than a boss – he was a mentor.

"I loved Jerry like a father and so much of who I am, today is because of him," Nimmons said. "He was definitely my biggest mentor and influence in my life"

Nimmons said Alexander taught the importance of fairness and character and that "nobody was better than anybody else."

"He showed me how to treat others and how to work for what you wanted in life and never give up or quit, no. matter how hard it gets," Nimmons said. "That man understood people better than anyone I have ever known, and I owe so much to him.

"That day in, 1983 when he took a chance on a poor kid from Six Mile that had no experience in newspapers changed my life. The world has lost one of the best men it's had"

While Alexander spent many years in newspapers, one of his greatest loves was local history – whether he was writing or talking about it

"Jerry was quite an interesting fellow to sit down and talk with, especially with the history he was aware of and knew personally that was very illuminating," said former State Sen. Larry Martin of Pickens. "He always had a great story to tell, knew everybody and was just a delightful person to know and be around."

Martin said Alexander was especially interested in local history dating back to the Cherokee Indians and that he"knew it like the back of his hand."

"Jerry appreciated all the modern developments we experienced in Pickens, and Oconee counties, but I don't think he ever got over the lake being built," Martin said: "He loved the fact we live in an area that, not too many years ago – less than 200 years ago, in fact – was pretty well dominated by Native Americans. As late as the 1820s, you had a population of Cherokee, and he knew all about that and was very artful in the interesting way in which he shared it."

Former Pickens County Museum director Allen Coleman said he knew Alexander through the museum and his interest in history.

"Anytime I dealt with Jerry, whether, it was a project he was working on, a book or coming by the museum to visit, he was one of the most jovial people I ever met," Coleman said. "I never heard him complain about anything."

While Coleman said Alexander's love of local history was apparent to anyone he met, it went far beyond citing facts and figures.

"He liked for his stories to resonate with people" Coleman said. "He had a good style that gave it color and personality, so to speak. I wish more people had a love of the past and would learn it and share it. Thank God for people like Jerry Alexander and Ken Burns."

State Rep. Davey Hiott of Pickens said Alexander was "a dear friend" to his family. As a youngster, Hiott remembered how Alexander would sit in his home, talking with his mom and dad, who printed his newspaper, and sharing stories about his life in the newspaper business.

"Jerry had a great sense of humor and a dry wit," Hiott said. "He was one of those guys who, when he would tell you a story, you would look at him and think, 'Is it true, or do I have to verify it?' He would give you that sly grin and could really write a column. My dad said he was one of the best writers around."

Nimmons said Alexander "was probably the best person I've known."

He could strike up a conversation with rich kids and strangers," he said.

Nimmons said his mentor seemed to enjoy a "Midas touch."

"Whatever he touched made him successful" he said.

A memorial service was held Sunday at Seneca Baptist Church.



Born in Oconee County, he was the son of the late Dennis Edward and Florence Ethel "Ann" Moody Crawford.

Edward was a retired Architectural Draftsman with Clemson University and a member of Cannon Memorial Baptist Church. He was an active member of the Sons of Confederate Veterans and the Pickens County Historical Society. He loved history and did extensive research on his family genealogy.
