

HISTORY HAPPENINGS with Vanessa Cole

NATIVE AMERICAN NAMES IN THE UPSTATE MEANINGS OF SOME OF THE NAMES

I wish walls could talk. For those who have been on my bus tours, we have gone to old school buildings and every time we do I say the same thing that I can almost hear the children laughing and chattering, I can almost hear them reciting their spelling words or multiplication tables. The same goes for old stores. My imagination puts me on the porch listening to the gossip of the ladies or the men talk about current events.

Forests are no different and if trees could talk, they'd tell stories of those who once lived those forests. If trees could talk, they'd tell stories of the natives, their villages, and their lives. Long before there were roads, maps, street signs and GPS, the natives used trees as a guide; the trees would tell of native travels. The trees would also tell of the forced removal of the Cherokees from their land.

In the upstate, there were twenty-seven Cherokee villages by the middle of the 17th century. They were known as the Lower Towns. Villages were located near fertile river bottoms. Homes were wooden frames covered with woven saplings and vines plastered with mud; roofs were thatched. Villages were surrounded by a wall of tall poles, contained 30-60 homes, and a council house large enough to seat 400-500 villagers. They farmed and hunted, and their diet consisted of corn, beans, squash, sunflowers, melons, bear, deer, other crops and wild game.

Two chiefs were elected in each village: a Peace Chief who led in times of peace and a War Chief who led in times of war. Chiefs did not rule absolutely, however. Politics and decision making was a democratic process with all tribal members, including the women, having an equal voice in the affairs of the tribe. They were a matrilineal society and kinship was traced through the mother's line.

Some of those towns included Oconee, Eastatoe, Seneca, Keowee, Tamassee, Toxaway, and Jocassee. There are numerous place names here in the upstate which carry on the history of those who were here long before the English. Below is a list of a few of those names.



Keowee-"place of the mulberries" Oconee-"land beside the water" Eastatoe-"place of the green birds" Toxaway-possibly "land of the red bird" Tamassee-"place of the sunlight of God" Ellijay-"green earth" Chauga-"rabbit place" Oolenoy-the Cherokee name of a spiny softshelled turtle

How History Happening Got Started

In March 2020 when the great COVID shut-down occurred, Vanessa Cole was completely cut off from doing her monthly historical programs in the retirement communities she visits every month. Knowing that the residents would not be able to have any activities come to them physically, several weeks later she had an idea of how to keep in touch with the residents and share stories of history until she could present her programs again in person. The idea was to write a weekly history story, send it to the activities directors and then they would distribute it to the residents in their community. With that *History Happenings with Vanessa* was born.

After the restrictions were lifted and Vanessa was able to go back into the communities, she was going to stop doing them but found that the residents wanted her to continue and so she did. As time went on, some of Vanessa's friends and acquaintances heard about *History Happenings* and asked to be included so they now go out weekly to a number of people. By the end of 2022, Vanessa will have written and sent out 141 issues of *History Happenings with Vanessa*.

Update on Mauldin Family write-up in recent issues by Marianne Holland

In the February issues of OLD PENDLETON MESSENGER, this writer observed on page 4 a picture of the James Benjamin Hester Family. One of the ladies in the photograph was identified as Susan Victoria Hester, the daughter of James Benjamin Hester and his first wife, Elmira L. Williams (1830-1958). The rest of the article focused on the children by James Baylis Hester's second wife, Lucetta Mauldin.

However, there were three children by the first wife, Elmira Williams. The first one, a son, Millard Fillmore Hester was born in 1855 and died in 1928. When one googles Millard Hester, the results do not show James B. Hester and Elmira as his parents. The persons listed are unknown to any of Millard's descendants. The list of Millard and his wife's children is correct on the google site. It is in the interest of this writer to make an addition to the information provided in the *OLD PENDLETON MESSENGER*, because Millard Fillmore Hester was my great grandfather. Millard married Mary Tullah Looper (daughter of Jeremiah Looper and his third wife, Martha Mauldin (1842-1935) who was a sister of Lucetta Mauldin 2nd wife of James Baylis Hester). This information indicates that Lucetta was the aunt of Mary Tullah Hester. Millard Fillmore Hester and Mary Tullah Hester's children were Martha (called Mattie), Walter, Wilton, Claude, Kate (1882-1968), Theron, Ralph, and Pearle. Kate married Arthur Cleveland Gravely in 1906, and their 2nd child, Mary Gravely, was this writer's mother.

The two other children of James Baylis Hester and Elmira Williams were

Susan Victoria Hester (1856-1927) who married John Tyler Hill (1841-1935) and moved to Oklahoma. This couple had three children.

Josephine Edith Hester (1858-1922) married John Keeler (1850-1934) and moved to Travelers Rest, SC, and this couple had eleven children. The family story that has come down by word of mouth is that Elmira died after giving birth to Josephine Edith in 1858. James Baylis then married Lucetta Mauldin (1843-1931). As a young child, there recollections of my grandmother calling the children of James Baylis and Lucetta, "Uncle Son", and the other relatives "cousins."

Since a number of relatives of the children of Millard and Mary Tullah still live in the upcountry, this author felt the need to make the information available to the OLD PENDLETON MESSENGER.

Sources: Personal talks with grandmother, Kate Hester Gravely (daughter of Millard Filmore Hester), and Gravely/Hester Bible Mauldin Family Chart developed by the late General Frank McFall (1860-1939) on the Rucker Mauldin line dating from about 1650 until the late 1800s. General McFall is buried at Sunrise Cemetery in Pickens.

Prior to coming to NGU, she taught choral music at Dreher High School and Spring Valley High Schools. She was co-authored the book, THE WORLD HISTORY APPROACH TO THE HUMANITIES, receiving a grant from the US Department of Education to teach World History in a different way. While at Spring Valley, she wrote a project grant for teaching the

Arts for students with special needs and for more than five years, received financial aid to bring teachers to Spring Valley to teach drama, art, music, and dance for students with special needs.

James McCollum

The articles regarding the Mauldin Community are very interesting. I am a descendant of Rucker Mauldin and his 2nd wife, Nancy Posey Smith and am always interested in learning about Rucker since his lineage has been a subject of debate for many years.

I do not know the McCollum family but am interested to know how this family may be associated with the Rucker Mauldin family.

I found an 1850 census record for James McCollum who lived in the Eastern Division of Pickens County, SC. He was 56 years of age (this would make his birth year 1794). In addition to him, the following are living in his household:

Eliza McCollum – age 41 (this would have been his wife)

Jane McCollum - age 22 (birthdate would have been 1828)

Elizabeth A. McCollum -age 20 (birthdate would have been 1830)

Malissa McCollum - age 18 (birthdate would have been 1832)

James W. McCollum - age 16 (birthdate would have been 1834)

Martha McCollum – age 13 (birthdate would have been 1837)

William E. McCullum – age 10 (birthdate would have been 1840)

Comparing the 1850 census to the children noted in Part VII of the Mauldin Community, I notice there is no John Wesley McCollum in the household of James McCollum in the 1850 census. This could mean that John Wesley McCollum belongs to a different McCollum family or either he was wrongly noted as James W. McCollum in the 1850 census)

I did find a death certificate for William E. McCollum - it notes his mother's maiden name as Eliza Mullinax, which means that she was probably not a daughter of Rucker Mauldin and Susannah nee Miller Mauldin, although I believe they did have a daughter named Elizabeth but no one seems to have information about her. However, the possibility exists that she could have been born a Mauldin, married a Mullinax first who may have died, and then she married James McCollum.

There is an obit in the Pickens Sentinel - June 1881 noting the death of a James McCollum – address noted as Easley Station but no family members were included.
